4. A fire hydrant was hit and damaged at the intersection of Main Street and Shore Road. We have the police report of who hit the hydrant.

5. Well No. 7 will be put back on line today after the well improvements.

6. Superintendent wanted to advise the Board that one of his cousins will be doing business in the District as an irrigation contractor and he will be treated the same as everyone else who deals with the District.

Checks for payment of claims, due from the Port Washington Water District totaling \$32,411.54 were approved for payment by the Board.
