- 1. The Long Island Commission for Aquifer Protection (LICAP) has provided the Water District with nine smart irrigation controllers to give away, free of charge on a first come, first-served basis, to residents of the District. The Superintendent will coordinate promotion of the free controllers with the District's public relations consultant.
- 2. Reviewed proposal for the repair and replacement of the garage and field office roofs at the Sandy Hollow Road site.
- 3. Discussed the need for capital planning.

William Merklin P.E. reported on the following:

1. Beacon Hill Tank Replacement – Electric service for the site is scheduled to be energized today. A field meeting for the installation of the controls to operate the tank is scheduled for tomorrow.

Peter Fishbein, Esq. – Reported in executive session.
