

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be conducted at the District Office, 38 Sandy Hollow Road, Port Washington on Wednesday, June 5, 2024 at 7 PM to inform the residents and taxpayers of the Port Washington Water District of the need to increase and improve its facilities as follows: Sandy Hollow Station Wells 1 and 2 PFAS Treatment Enhancement; Neulist Station Site, Mechanical and Chemical Improvements; Hewlett Station Well 4 PFAS Treatment Enhancement; Bar Beach Station Well 6 PFAS Treatment, Raising of Well and Miscellaneous Improvements; Ricks Station Well 7 PFAS Treatment, Raising of Well and Miscellaneous Improvements; Morley Park Station PTAS Building Roof Enclosure; Longview Booster Station Electrical, Lighting and SCADA Upgrades and Replacement of Bilco Hatches and Stairs; Replacement of Cast Iron Water Mains; and Southport Station Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation and Miscellaneous Improvements; including any and all necessary furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, installations, appurtenances, accessories and related engineering and other costs in connection with the foregoing, all as further described in detail in the engineering report dated May 2024, prepared by D&B Engineers and Architects, D.P.C., engineers duly licensed by the State of New York, on behalf of the District, at the estimated maximum cost of \$61,000,700. The District will petition the Town of North Hempstead for bonding in this amount to cover the cost of these projects. At said public hearing, the Port Washington Water District will hear all persons interested in said subject matter thereof.
